

How to Use Photo Frames

Using your new photo frames is very simple. Your download included two types of files – PaintShop Pro frames (.pspframe) and transparent PNGs. Below are instructions for both file types.

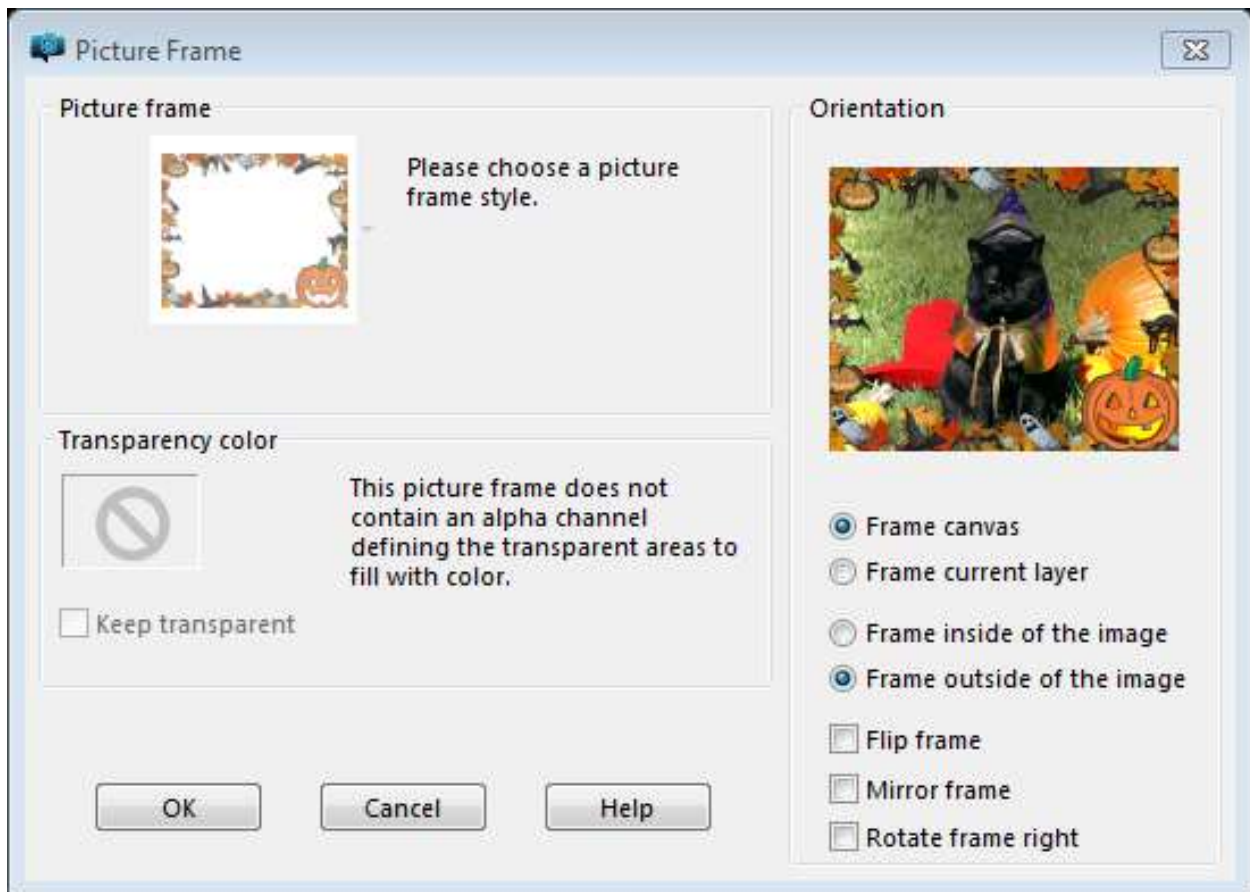
Using .pspframes in PaintShop Pro

After downloading your .pspframe files, it's helpful to get into the habit of storing them in the proper location. This way, they will display in the gallery in the Picture Frame dialog box. Browse to the following location to paste the frame files you have downloaded:

C:\Users\YOURNAME\Documents\Corel PaintShop Pro\2019\Picture Frames

*If you are using an earlier version of PaintShop Pro, replace **2019** in the filepath above with your version.*

If you want to make sure that the frame is in the correct location, go to **Image > Picture Frames** and click on the drop-down list in the top left corner and your frame should be in the gallery.



Now you're all set to use your new PaintShop Pro picture frame. Use the options on the right to place the frame inside or outside your image, flip or rotate to get the look you want.

Using Transparent PNG Frames

If you are not a PaintShop Pro user, you will want to use the PNG files instead of the PaintShop Pro frames. These frames can be used with any graphic design or photo editing software that supports transparencies and layers.

Simply open the frame and photo that you want to use. Select the frame, copy and paste it onto the photo. You just need to make sure that the frame is in the top layer, with the photo underneath it. You may have to resize either the frame or photo to fit properly.
